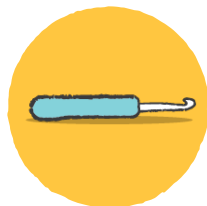


THE WOOBLES

SETUP

MATERIALS



4mm crochet hook



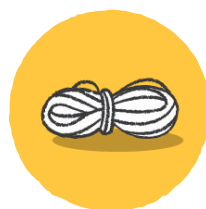
Tapestry needle



Scissors
(not included)

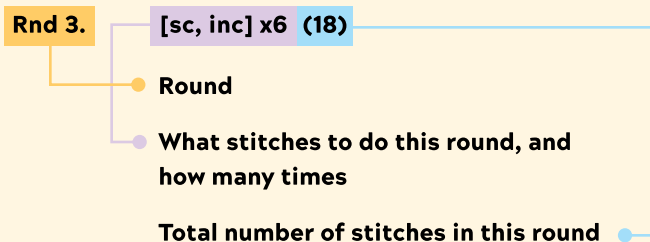


Red medium-weight
yarn (5 yds)



White medium-weight
yarn (4 yds)

HOW TO READ A WOOBLES PATTERN



For round 3, repeat the pattern in the brackets 6 times. The pattern is: single crochet in 1 stitch, then increase stitch in the next stitch. Because an increase is actually 2 single crochet stitches in the same stitch of the previous round, the total number of stitches in this round is 18.

ABBREVIATIONS

This pattern is written in US terminology, and crocheted in continuous rounds. Watch video tutorials at thewobles.com/tutorials

ch	chain
sc	single crochet
st	stitch
sl st	slip stitch

PATTERN

COVER

With red yarn.

- Row 1.** ch 11 (11)
Row 2. starting from the second chain from the hook, 10 sc, ch 1 and turn (10)
Rows 3-5. 10 sc, ch 1 and turn (10)
Row 6. 10 sc (10)

Step 1.

Ch 1 and **do not** turn.

Step 2.

Sc into the same stitch and then 4 sc down the short edge.

Step 3.

Ch 1. Sc into the same st and then 9 sc down the long edge. Since this is the foundation chain from the beginning of the cover, crochet through only the front loop of the foundation chain.

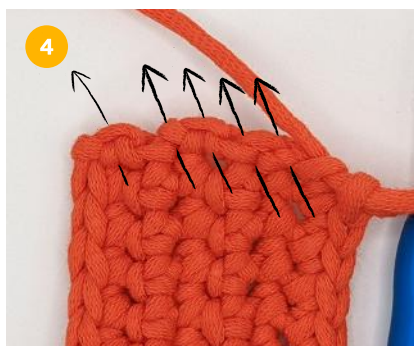
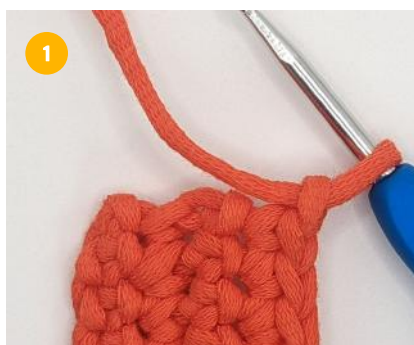
Step 4.

Ch 1. Sc into the same st and then 4 sc down the short edge.

Step 5.

Ch 1 and sl st into the first st of the long edge.

Fasten off and weave in the tails.



PAGES

With white yarn.

Row 1. ch 9 (9)

Row 2. starting from the second chain from the hook, 7 sc, ch 1 and turn (8)

Rows 3-4. 8 sc, ch 1 and turn (8)

Row 5. 8 sc (8)

Step 1.

Ch 1 and **do not** turn.

Step 2.

Sc into the same st and then 3 sc down one edge.

Step 3.

Ch 1. Sc into the same st and then 7 sc down the edge.

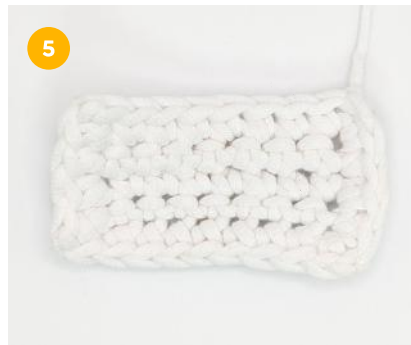
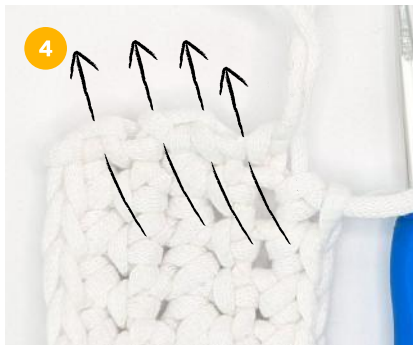
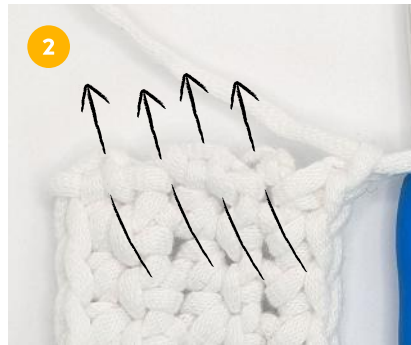
Step 4.

Ch 1. Sc into the same st and then 3 sc down the edge.

Step 5.

Ch 1 and sl st into the first st of the long edge.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail.



Next, attach the pages to the book.

Thread a needle with the yarn tail and use it to sew the pages onto the book cover:

Step 1.

Weave the tail into the long edge of the pages until you reach the middle.

Step 2.

Sew the center of the pages to the book cover. Make sure that the yarn doesn't show on the outside of the book cover.

Step 3.

Once you've reached the other end of the book, bring the yarn tail up and over the center of the pages. Weave the tail behind the pages.
