




HOW TO READ A WOOBLES PATTERN



For round 3, repeat the pattern in the brackets 6 times. The pattern is: single crochet in 1 stitch, then increase stitch in the next stitch. Because an increase is actually 2 single crochet stitches in the same stitch of the previous round, the total number of stitches in this round is 18.

ABBREVIATIONS

This pattern is written in US terminology, and crocheted in continuous rounds. Watch video tutorials at thewoobles.com/tutorials

ch chain

sc single crochet

PATTERN

BROOMSTICK

With brown yarn.

Row 1. ch 10 (10)

Row 2. sc in the second stitch from the

hook, 8 sc, ch 1 and turn (9)

Row 3. sc in the second stitch from the

hook, 8 sc (9)

Fasten off leaving a long tail. Thread a needle with the tail; then use it to whip stitch both sides together:

Step 1.

Line up row 1 and row 3 back-to-back, and tuck the other tail inside the broomstick.

Step 2.

Whip stitch together each sc in row 3 with the remaining foundation chain loop across from it in row 1

Weave in the yarn tail.





BRISTLES

With tan and brown yarn.

To make the bristles, attach strands of tan yarn to one end of the broom:

Step 1.

Cut at least twelve 4-inch strands of tan yarn.

Step 2.

Insert the hook all the way through one end of the broomstick.

Step 3.

Pull three strands of tan yarn through at a time, repeating until all twelve strands are in the end of the broomstick.

Step 4.

Wrap a hand's length piece of brown yarn around the tan yarn, about half an inch from where the bristles and the broomstick meet. Double knot to secure.

Step 5.

Pull the ends of the brown yarn through the loops of the tan yarn and weave them into the broomstick.

Step 6.

Trim the ends of the tan yarn to be about one inch from where the brown yarn is wrapped around the bristles.
