

WOÖBLES

SETUP

MATERIALS



4mm crochet hook



Tapestry needle



White medium-weight yarn (20 yds)




Red medium-weight yarn (1 yds)



Scissors (not included)

HOW TO READ A WOOBLES PATTERN



For round 3, repeat the pattern in the brackets 6 times. The pattern is: single crochet in 1 stitch, then increase stitch in the next stitch. Because an increase is actually 2 single crochet stitches in the same stitch of the previous round, the total number of stitches in this round is 18.

ABBREVIATIONS

This pattern is written in US terminology, and crocheted in continuous rounds. Watch video tutorials at thewoobles.com/tutorials

sc single crochet

inc increase (2 sc in the same hole)

rnd round
ch chain
st stitch

PATTERN

HAT

With white yarn.

Rnd 1. start 6 sc in a magic loop (6)

Rnd 2. 6 inc (12)

Rnd 3. [sc, inc] x 6 (18) **Rnd 4.** [2 sc, inc] x 6 (24) **Rnd 5.** [3 sc, inc] (30)

Rnds 6-7. 30 sc (30)

Invisible fasten off leaving a tail. Thread a needle with the tail and weave it into the edge of the piece.

BRIM

Row 1. ch 13 (13)

Row 2. starting from the second ch from the hook, 12 sc, ch 1 and turn (12)

Row 3. [3 sc, inc] x 3, ch 1 and turn (15)

Row 4. [2 sc, inc] x 5 (20)

Fasten off leaving a long tail.

EMBROIDERY

With red yarn.

Hold the brim so the original yarn tail is on the left. If you're a lefty, the original yarn tail should be on the right. Embroider the cross:

Step 1.

Thread a needle with an arm's length of yarn. To create the vertical line, insert the needle from the back to the front of the center of the piece, above row 3. Then insert your needle two rows down, right above the foundation chain. Leave a 6-inch yarn tail.

Step 2.

Create the horizontal line. Insert the needle from the back to the front of the piece, one row up and one stitch to the left. Then pull it out two stitches to the right.

Step 3.

Tie the yarn tails in a knot, and trim them close to the knot.







ASSEMBLY

Step 1.

Thread a needle with the brim's yarn tail. Hold the brim to the main part of the hat so that the shorter of the two long edges lines up with the bottom edge of the hat. Secure the short edge of the brim down by sewing it to the main part of the hat.

Step 2.

Sew the bottom of the brim to the edge of the main part of the hat.





Step 3.

Secure the other short edge to the main part of the hat.

Weave in the yarn tail.

NOTE

The brim should stick out and away from the main part of the hat.
