Why Host a Lions Quest Community Forum?

To provide an interactive forum for people to learn and connect around the importance of engaging with children & youth in their community to support mental well-being with a focus on building effective, developmental relationships with young people.

The community can be defined geographically (ex. neighbourhood, municipality) or by common characteristics (ex. Lions, Coaches).

Benefits to Lions/Leo Clubs

Promote Lions/Leos work with young people to the community & through the media Provides cost effective way to demonstrate need for Lions Quest programs in schools Connects you with other community leaders focused on children & youth Potential membership development strategy

Online Option

90 minutes via Zoom \$750 fee to cover presenter, online platform, and material Limited to an absolute maximum of 24 participants plus facilitator (minimum of 10)

In Person Option

3 hours

\$1,500 fee to cover presenter & material - plus travel & on-site expenses Local costs – facility, snacks, AV (facility requirements will be provided) Flexibility on group size (minimum of 10, ideally 20-40 participants)
