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Artisan/Crafter Consignment Application Process

The Brooklyn Women's Exchange is a not-for-profit, volunteer run shop supporting handcraft makers since 1854. The BWE is always looking for new artisans/crafters for consignment. The shop is open all year round and also offers online shopping on our [website](#). Seventy percent of the retail price is returned to the crafter/artisan with the remainder being used to cover shop costs such as heat and light.

All crafters applying for consignment are reviewed by our Merchandise Committee who meet on a monthly basis. Key elements of the review include craftsmanship and suitability for the shop. Once the crafter's work has been reviewed someone from the committee will contact the crafter about the next steps.

If you're able to drop off your work in person, please bring it along with the completed Consignor Inventory Form to the shop for the Merchandise Committee to review. If you're unable to drop off your work, please contact our shop manager, [Elizabeth Betteil](#) to discuss alternate arrangements.
