Lacey Shawl Scarf

MATERIALS

1 ball of Scheepjes Whirl – 215-225 grams / 1000 meters, example colour is Night Time Bubbles

3.5mm needles (I prefer circular needles with an 80cm cord) Tapestry needle to weave in your ends (only 2 ends, yay!)

NOTES

Gauge = 25 stitches and 30 rows to 10cm

This shawl is worked lengthways.

Cast on 504 stitches for 100 inches long and 14 inches width, after blocking. Allow 10 meters of yarn to cast on.

Pattern is worked with a 10 stitch repeat. If you'd like the shawl wider in width and shorter in length, decrease the cast on stitches by 10, i.e. cast on either 494, 484, or 474 etc.

STITCH GUIDE

k - knit stitch

k2tog – knit 2 stitches together (decreasing 1 stitch)

p – purl stitch

p2tog – purl 2 stitches together (decreasing 1 stitch)

rep - repeat stitches between *asterisks*

(rs) - right side

s1k2psso – slip one stitch knitwise, k2tog, pass over the slipped stitch over and off your right needle (decreasing 2 stitches)

s1kw – with yarn at the back, slip one stitch knitwise

s1pw – with yarn at the front, slip one stitch purlwise

 \mathbf{ssk} – slip one stitch knitwise, slip next stitch knitwise, insert left needle through fronts of slipped stitches and knit the two stitches together

ssp – slip one stitch knitwise, slip next stitch knitwise, slip them back onto left needle without twisting the stitches, purl through back loops (decreasing 1 stitch) **st(s)** – stitch(es)

(ws) – wrong side

yo - yarn over needle to make a stitch increase

SET UP ROWS

Cast on the number of stitches depending on your chosen size

(ws) s1kw, knit to end

(rs) slkw k1 *yo ssk k8* k2

(ws) slpw *p1 yo p2tog p5 ssp yo* p3

SHAWL

1 (rs) s1kw k3 *yo ssk k3 k2tog yo k3*

2 (ws) slpw p3 *yo p2tog p1 ssp yo p5*

3 (rs) slkw k3 *k2 yo s1k2psso yo k5*

4 (ws) slpw p1 ***p3 ssp yo*** rep to last 2 sts, p2

5 (rs) slkw k2 *yo ssk k3* rep to last st, k1

6 (ws) s1pw p2 *ssp yo p3* rep to last st, p1 7 (rs) s1kw k1 *k3 yo ssk* rep to last 2 sts, k2

8 (ws) slpw *ssp yo p3* rep to last 3 sts, p3

9 (rs) slkw k1 ***yo ssk k3*** rep to last 2 sts, k2

10 (ws) slpw ***p1 yo p2tog p5 ssp yo*** rep to last 3 sts, p3

11 (rs) s1kw k3 *yo ssk k3 k2tog yo k3*

12 (ws) slpw p3 *yo p2tog p1 ssp yo p5*

13 (rs) slkw k3 *k2 yo s1k2psso yo k5*

14 (ws) slpw p2 *p3 yo p2tog* rep to last st, p1

15 (rs) slkw k3 *k1 k2tog yo k2*

16 (ws) s1pw p2 ***yo p2tog p3*** rep to last st, p1

17 (rs) s1kw k2 ***k2tog yo k3*** rep to last st, k1

18 (ws) slpw p1 ***p3 yo p2tog*** rep to last 2 sts, p2

19 (rs) slkw ***k2tog yo k3*** rep to last 3 sts, k3

20 (ws) slpw *p1 yo p2tog p5 ssp yo* rep to last 3 sts, p3

Repeat rows 1 to 20 until desired width, finishing on a right side, preferable finishing on either row 5 or 15 so the design is symmetrical

CAST OFF ROWS

(ws) slkw, knit to end

(rs) cast off loosely purlwise

Block your work to open up the lace pattern.

- Right or wrong side of work
