Waves Shawl

MATERIALS/NOTES

1 ball of Scheepjes Whirl – 215-225 grams / 1000 meters, example colour is Dandelion Munchies
3.5mm needles (I prefer circular needles with an 80cm cord)
Tapestry needle to weave in your ends (only 2 ends, yay!)

42 stitch markers – We'll use markers to give you various stopping points if you'd like to put down your work mid-way through the long rows. When you reach a marker, it is when you are at the end of a repeat section.

NOTES

Gauge = 25 stitches and 30 rows to 10cm

Cast on 380 stitches for 20 inches width and 80 inches long, after blocking.

Pattern is worked with a 9 stitch repeat. If you'd like the shawl wider and shorter in length, cast on either 371, 362, or 353 etc. If you'd like the shawl narrower and longer in length, cast on either 389, 398, or 407 etc

STITCH GUIDE

k – knit stitch

k2tog – knit 2 stitches together (decreasing 1 stitch)

p – purl stitch

p2tog - purl 2 stitches together (decreasing 1 stitch)

p2togtbl - purl 2 stitches together through back loop
(decreasing 1 stitch)

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pm – place marker

rep - repeat stitches between *asterisks*

(rs) - right side

ssk – slip one stitch knitwise, slip another stitch knitwise, knit the stitch (decreasing 1 stitch)

st(s) - stitch(es)

yo – yarn over needle to make a stitch increase

(ws) – wrong side

SET UP ROWS

Cast on your chosen number of stitches.

(ws) k1 pm *k9 pm* repeat to the last st, k1.

SHAWL

1 (rs) k1 *ssk k7 yo* rep to last st k1

2 (ws) p1 *p1 yo p6 p2togtbl* rep to last st p1

3 (rs) k1 *ssk k5 yo k2* rep to last st k1

4 (ws) p1 *p3 yo p4 p2togtbl* rep to last st p1

5 (rs) k1 *k3 k2tog k4 yo* rep to last st k1

6 (ws) p1 *p1 yo p4 p2tog p2* rep to last st p1

7 (rs) k1 *k1 k2tog k4 yo k2* rep to last st k1

8 (ws) p1 *p3 yo p4 p2tog* rep to last st p1

9 (rs) k1 *yo k3 k2tog k4* rep to last st k1

10 (ws) p1 *p4 p2tog p2 yo p1* rep to last st p1

11 (rs) k1 *k2 yo k1 k2tog k4* rep to last st k1

12 (ws) p1 *p4 p2tog yo p3* rep to last st p1

13 (rs) k1 *yo k7 k2tog* rep to last st k1

14 (ws) p1 *p2tog p6 yo p1* rep to last st p1

15 (rs) k1 *k2 yo k5 k2tog* rep to last st k1

16 (ws) p1 *p2tog p4 yo p3* rep to last st p1

17 (rs) k1 *yo k4 ssk k3* rep to last st k1

18 (ws) p1 *p2 p2togtbl p4 yo p1* rep to last st p1

19 (rs) k1 *k2 yo k4 ssk k1* rep to last st k1

20 (ws) p1 *p2togtbl p4 yo p3* rep to last st p1

21 (rs) k1 *k4 ssk k3 yo* rep to last st k1

22 (ws) p1 *p1 yo p2 p2togtbl p4* rep to last st p1

23 (rs) k1 *k4 ssk k1 yo k2* rep to last st k1

24 (ws) p1 *p3 yo p2togtbl p4* rep to last st p1

Repeat rows 1 to 24, until desired shawl width. Finish on a right side.

CAST OFF ROWS

(ws) cast off loosely purlwise

Block your work to open up the lace pattern.
