EYE CONTACT

Make sure to remove any contact lenses from the eyes before rinsing. Promptly wash eyes with plenty of water while lifting the eye lids. Continue to rinse for at least 15 minutes. Contact physician if irritation persists.

5 FIRE-FIGHTING MEASURES

EXTINGUISHING MEDIA

Fire can be extinguished using: Foam. Carbon dioxide or dry powder.

SPECIAL FIRE FIGHTING PROCEDURES

Avoid breathing fire vapors.

PROTECTIVE MEASURES IN FIRE

Wear full protective clothing.

6 ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

SPILL CLEAN UP METHODS

Extinguish all ignition sources. Avoid sparks, flames, heat and smoking. Ventilate. Absorb in vermiculite, dry sand or earth and place into containers.

HANDLING

All handling to take place in well-ventilated area.

STORAGE

Store in a cool, dark place (0-25°C, 32-77°F). Keep away from heat, sparks and open flame.

STORAGE CLASS

Chemical storage.

ENGINEERING MEASURES

Provide adequate general and local exhaust ventilation.

HAND PROTECTION

Wear protective gloves.

EYE PROTECTION

Wear approved safety goggles.

Wear appropriate clothing to prevent any possibility of skin contact.

HYGIENE MEASURES

DO NOT SMOKE IN WORK AREA! Wash at the end of each work shift and before eating, smoking and using the toilet. Wash promptly with soap & water if skin becomes contaminated. Promptly remove any clothing that becomes contaminated. Use appropriate skin cream to prevent drying of skin. When using do not eat, drink or smoke.
