



ANIMER TRIANGLE SHAWLETTE

MATERIALS

- 3 Hanks AMANO YARN ECO PUNA (100 grs), #9000 Nevado White
- 32" Length circular knitting needle, size 5 (3.75 mm) OR SIZE TO OBTAIN GAUGE

SKILL SIZE

Easy

One Size.

FINISHED MEASUREMENT

Wingspan - 74" (188 cm) Depth - 34" (86 cm)

GAUGE

18 sts = 4" (10.2 cm); 31 rows = 4" (10.2 cm) in St st after blocking

TO SAVE TIME, TAKE TIME TO CHECK GAUGE



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NOTE

This triangular shawl is knitted from the bottom up. Increases are made at the beginning and end of every right side row. The size of the shawl can be adjusted by knitting fewer or additional repeats of the pattern.

STITCH GLOSSARY

MB: Make bobble: (Kfb) twice into same stitch (4 sts) TURN, sl1 wyif, p3, TURN, sl 1 wyib, k3, TURN, sl1 wyif, p3, TURN, sl 1 wyib, k3, slip the 2nd, 3rd and 4th sts over the 1st stitch.

SHAWL

Using the long tail method, cast on $5\,\mathrm{sts}.$

Row 1 (WS): Sl 1 wyif, k4.

Row 2 (RS): Sl 1 wyif, kfb, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 - (7 sts).

Row 3: Sl 1 wyif, knit to end.

Rows 4 - 9: Rep rows 1 & 2 three (3) times - (13 sts). Row 10: Sl 1 wyif, kfb, k4, MB, knit to last 2 sts,

kfb, k1 - (15 sts).

Row 11: Sl 1 wyif, k6, p1, knit to end.

Row 12: Sl 1 wyif, kfb, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1 - (17 sts).

Rows 13, 15, 17 & 19: Sl 1 wyif, k5, purl to last 6 sts, k6.

Rows 14, 16 & 18: Sl 1 wyif, kfb, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1.

Row 20: SI 1 wyif, kfb, k4, MB, knit to last 7 sts, MB, kfb, k5 - (25 sts).

Rows 21, 23, 25, 27 & 29: Sl 1 wyif, k5, purl to last 6 sts, k6.

Rows 22, 24, 26 & 28: Sl 1 wyif, kfb, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1.

Row 30: Sl 1 wyif, kfb, k4, MB, knit to last 7 sts, MB, kfb, k5 - (35 sts).

Pattern repeat

Rep rows 21 – 30 twenty-six (26) times more – (295 sts).

Garter Stitch Edging

Note: Increases are made on each of the rows

of the Garter Stitch Edging.

Rows 1 - 6: Sl 1 wyif, kfb, knit to last 2 sts, kfb, k1.

Note: Bind off using your favorite stretchy bind off technique or use the bind off method below.

Bind off: K2, slip the sts back on the left needle and k2tog tbl, *k1, slip the 2 sts from the right needle to the left needle and k2tog tbl*, rep from * to * until all sts have been bound off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block to measurements.

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ABBREVIATIONS & TERMS

beg: beginningBO: bind offCO: cast oncn: cable needledec: decrease

dpn: double pointed needles

K: knit

k tbl: knit through the back loop(s)k2tog: Knit 2 stitches togetherk3tog: Knit 3 stitches together

LH: left hand

M1: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from

front to back, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1L: Work as for M1.

M1p: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from front to back, place on left hand needle, purl this stitch through the back (1 stitch increased).

M1R: Pick up horizontal strand between stitch just worked and next stitch from back to front, place on left hand needle, knit this stitch through the front (1 stitch increased).

p: purl

PM: place marker

psso: pass slip stitch over knit stitch

p1d: purl 1 st by going under the stitch below and working through both sts.

p2tog: purl 2 stitches together

rep: repeat
RH: right hand
rnd(s): round(s)
RS: right side
sl: slip

 $\textbf{sl2tog-k1-psso:} \ \mathsf{Slip} \ 2 \ \mathsf{together} \ (\mathsf{as} \ \mathsf{if} \ \mathsf{to} \ \mathsf{k2tog}), \ \mathsf{knit} \ \mathsf{1},$

pass the 2 slipped stitches over.

SM: slip marker

ssk: Slip 2 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 2 stitches and knit 2 together.

sssk: Slip 3 stitches knitwise, insert point of left hand needle through fronts of these 3 stitches and knit 3

together.
st(s): stitch(es)

TBL: through back loop(s)

tog: together
WS: wrong side
wyib: with yarn in back
wyif: with yarn in front
yo: yarn over

end on WS: end having just completed a Wrong Side

row

end on RS: end having just completed a Right Side

.WC

STOCKINETTE ST (St st): Knit 1 row, purl 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The knit side is the right side of work. Knit EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

Reverse St st (Rev St st): Purl 1 row, knit 1 row alternately when working on straight needles. The purl side is the right side of the work. Purl EVERY round when working in the round on a circular needle.

GARTER ST: Knit EVERY row when working on straight needles. Knit 1 round, purl 1 round when working on a circular needle.

K1, p1 Rib: Knit 1 st, purl 1 st.

3 Needle Bind Off: With RS together, hold in one hand two needles with the same number of sts on each. with third needle, knit tog 1 st from each needle, *knit tog one st from each needle, pass first st over second to bind off, repeat from *to last st.

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
