

Find Your Ring Size

We'll put our hands up and say we have a thing for rings. We can't get enough of layering, matching, and adding beautiful new styles to our stacks. Admittedly, though, shopping for rings online can be a little trickier than other types of jewellery such as chains and earrings.

Fortunately, we have you covered with our handy guide to finding the perfect ring size – so you can shop and stack to your heart's content.

MEASURE A CURRENT RING

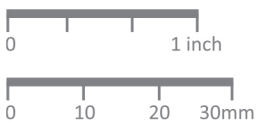
1. Select a ring that fits the finger you plan to wear your new ring on.
2. Place your ring over the nearest matching circle. Match the inside edge of the ring to the circle nearest in size.
3. If the ring size falls between two circles, order the larger size.
4. Measure twice, buy once.

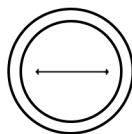
IS IT A SURPRISE?

Ask your significant other's friends or family if they know her finger size. Borrow one of their rings (from the correct finger) and use the ring measurements below to determine the correct ring size.

CONFIRM PRINTED SCALE



1. Prior to printing, ensure that page scaling is set to "None" in the print dialog box.
2. Measure the scale bar on the left to ensure it is exactly 1 inch or 30mm long. If the measurement is not accurate, check that you are printing the page at full size and reprint before continuing.
