

2021 'PALI VINEYARD' SPARKLING ROSÉ OF PINOT NOIR

- 100% PINOT NOIR
- Sta. Rita Hills Santa Barbara County, California
- AGED IN 100% NEUTRAL FRENCH OAK BARRELS 8 MONTHS, THEN INTRODUCED TO A SEC-ONDARY FERMENTATION WITHIN THE BOTTLE AND ALLOWED TO AGE FOR AN ADDITION-AL 6 MONTHS
- ALC. 12% BY VOL.

- Crisp Apple, Pear, Citrus Zest

This sparkling wine, made entirely from Pinot Noir grapes grown on our estate vineyard in the Sta. Rita Hills, 'Pali Vineyard,' is a nod to the sparkling wines of Champagne, France. With complete control over the farming and harvesting of the grapes, this wine is made with the utmost attention to detail and meticulous standards. Our vineyard, organically farmed and SIP (Sustainability in Practice) Certified, is located in the far northwestern corner of the Sta. Rita Hills atop sandy soils, exposing it to maximum ocean influence. This results in vines that ripen slowly, allowing an extended growing season to develop riper characteristics while maintaining the acidity essential for sparkling wine.

Following the tradition of Champagne, our Sparkling Rosé of Pinot Noir is meticulously crafted using the Méthode Champenoise. The base wine, a 100% rosé of Pinot Noir, is foot-stomped and whole-cluster pressed before aging in 100% neutral French oak barrels for eight months. The wine then undergoes secondary fermentation in the bottle, over six months, developing the signature 'Champagne bubbles'.
