2021'Summit' is made from Pinot Noir grown on Pali Vineyard, Fiddlestix Vineyard and Rancho La Viña Vineyard. While each of these sources are stand-outs in the region, and we bottle vineyard designated wines from each site, 'Summit' allows us to blend a component of each painting a more complete picture of the region as a whole.

The Sta. Rita Hills in Santa Barbara County is distinct for its transverse mountain ranges, which create a unique east-west valley opening directly to the Pacific Ocean. This geography leads to a cooler and more maritime-influenced climate, ideal for Pinot Noir, allowing grapes to hang longer on the vine. This extended ripening period leads to wines that express riper and fruitier characteristics, while still maintaining a vibrant acidity.
