2022 'Huntington' is made entirely from Pinot Noir grown on our estate vineyard in the Sta. Rita Hills in Santa Barbara County, allowing us to meticulously manage both the farming and harvesting of the grapes.

'Huntington' is designed to be an approachable Santa Barbara County Pinot Noir. It is defined by its elegant balance of ripe fruit flavors and bright acidity, influenced by the region's cool maritime climate and distinctive terroir. This terroir is marked by coastal influences, a variety of soil types from sandy to loamy, and east-west oriented valleys that channel cool ocean breezes, all contributing to the wine's unique character.

"This larger production bottling for the winery always delivers, starting this vintage with pomegranate, raspberry jam, toasted herb and light pepper aromas.
