

## 2022 'P.C.H.'

- 100% Rosé of Pinot Noir
- SANTA BARBARA COUNTY
- AGED IN 100% NEUTRAL FRENCH OAK BARRELS FOR 3 MONTHS
- ALC. 12% BY VOL.
- 500 CASES MADE
- STRAWBERRY, GRAPEFRUIT, CITRUS ZEST

2022 'P.C.H.' is made entirely from Pinot Noir grown on our estate vineyard in the Sta. Rita Hills of Santa Barbara County. This allows us to meticulously manage both the farming and harvesting of the grapes. This is particularly important for rosé, which is often made as a by-product of red winemaking. However, this is not the case here; 'P.C.H.' is grown and harvested specifically to become a rosé. Upon arrival at the winery, the grapes are lightly crushed and left to soak with the skins and juice for a couple of hours. This process integrates flavor and color before the grapes are whole-cluster pressed.

'P.C.H.' is an incredibly elegant rosé, bright with acidity and showcasing beautiful aromatics and full fruit flavors. It's not only elegant but also perfect for many occasions - from a day at the beach to an aperitif before a meal, or even as the main wine at dinner.
