ABOUT OUR 'WILD SERIES' ORANGE WINE

Our 'Wild Series' wines are fermented using wild, naturally occurring yeasts. The Pinot Noir grapes are sustainably farmed and grown on Pali Vineyard in the Sta. Rita Hills in Santa Barbara County, while the Gewurztraminer comes from Danny's Vineyard in Monterey which is sustainably farmed by the Francioni Brothers in honor of their late father. The grapes harvested for this orange wine are initially fermented with skin-contact which adds texture and flavor to the resulting wine. This wine is fermented using wild, naturally occurring yeasts and without the use of conventional winemaking tools and additives throughout its élevage. Once fermentation is complete, the wine is aged using 75% neutral oak and 25% stainless steel for 90 days. This wine is unfiltered and unfiltered and will naturally develop sediment.

WINEMAKER NOTES

At first sight, you'll note the amber haze in the bottle with a beautifully cloudy essence. The aromas of this wine resemble a bouquet of wild flowers, with a sparkle of apricot, honeysuckle, and elements of yuzu citrus. Once you get a taste, you're in heaven... orange blossom, guava, and white pepper on the palate, with a crisp mouthfeel.

Most recently, Pali has introduced its 'Wild Series,' natural wines made using only wild, naturally occurring yeasts that remain unfiltered and unfiltered.
