
You will need:

- 1 x Large yoghurt pot to recycle
- 1 x Light brown felt
- Cellophane sheets (2 yellow, 2 blue, 2 red)
- 6 x Green pipe cleaners
- Green craft felt or crepe paper
- Yellow pompoms





Cover the outside of a clean yoghurt pot in PVA glue and wrap in brown craft felt. Fold extra felt inside the yoghurt pot. Leave to dry.



Make a flower for the pot.



Cut a leaf shape from felt or crepe paper and set to one side.



From one sheet of yellow cellophane cut a large square. Place a yellow pompom in the centre and gather.



Wrap a pipe cleaner around once to secure.



Take a sheet of red or blue cellophane and cut into 6 equal squares and lay them in a pile.





Fold in quarters and cut a small hole at the corner. Open back out and lay flat.





Feed the pipe cleaner through the hole and push up to the pompom. Wrap pipe cleaner around the cellophane to secure.



Twist 2 more pipe cleaners with the left over pipe cleaner catching the leaf shape as you twist. Place the flower in the pot. To create soil, layer the cellophane with the yellow sheet on top, scrunch up and put into the pot.
