

# Esthetics and Functionality

The Heirloom Bobbin Winder is portable and designed to accommodate most bobbin styles and lengths used for Bobbin Lace. It features a switch to control the direction the bobbin is wound and to protect against accidental operation during transport. Each winder is battery operated and includes an AC adapter when a 120V outlet is accessible.

## **Inlays**

The Heirloom Bobbin Winder is decorated with a variety of different inlays which include diamond or checker patterns.



Each Heirloom Bobbin Winder is hand crafted from select Walnut and Maple hardwoods

Each Heirloom Bobbin Winder is individually handcrafted in Fort Collins, Colorado using select Walnut, Maple and the finest wood inlays made in the United States. It operates on 4-AA batteries located within the body of the bobbin winder. The moveable tailstock of the winder allows the user to ensure bobbins are securely held to reduce surface abrasion thus preserving bobbins that are hand painted. The Heirloom Bobbin Winder will accommodate bobbin lace bobbins up to 7 inches. It is portable, functional, and does not require any tools or clamps to set up or operate.

# High Quality to last for years

Each Heirloom Bobbin Winder is personally inspected to ensure the highest quality of material and workmanship. Each winder is made using high grade material including hardwoods, sealed ball bearings, stainless steel, and brass components to offer long lasting service.

#### **Bobbin Cups**

The cups that hold the bobbins are fitted with silicon inserts to securely hold the bobbin and protect the bobbin surface from abrasion.

#### **Price**

The winder is priced at \$275\* which includes an AC Adapter and owner's manual.
