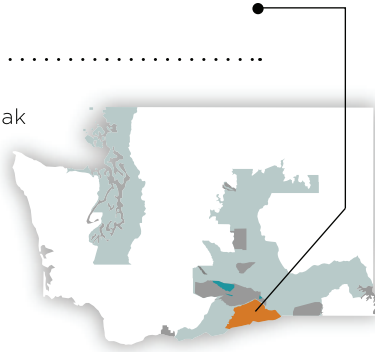

TWO BROTHERS. ONE PASSION. MADE BY OREGON.

What makes the Pacific Northwest so unique? The fact that dense forests, winding waterways, and snow-packed peaks are all in our backyard? Or is it that no matter how far you go and how many sights you see, there's always more to explore? Each wine is crafted with this reverence of place—but our goal is to never stop exploring new regions and new wines.

We're creating wine for those who cherish the wonder in wandering, who understand that the best places to explore are sometimes right around the corner, and for those of us who opt for the long way home. Inspired by the Pacific Northwest, and #MadebyOregon.

The 2021 Christopher Michael Cabernet Sauvignon is comprised of wine made entirely from grapes from the Horse Heaven Hills AVA, predominantly Phinny Hill Vineyard and Fountain Farms. We have chosen to work with these two growers as sources of Cabernet Sauvignon that highlights the best of the AVA, offering firm tannin (encouraged by the winds typical of the appellation) providing a structure upon which the generosity of fruit can rest. 2021 was a warm and historically low-yielding vintage throughout the AVA, leading to wines of great concentration.
