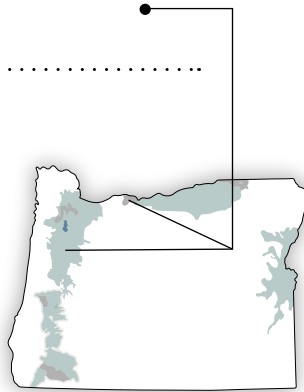

The 2021 vintage kicked off with early rain during bloom, leading to slightly reduced yields ahead of a warm summer marked by unprecedented heat spikes. These events contributed to phenolic maturity at low sugar levels, yielding wines of elegance and tension.
