What makes the Pacific Northwest so unique? The fact that dense forests, winding waterways, and snow-packed peaks are all in our backyard? Or is it that no matter how far you go and how many sights you see, there's always more to explore? Each wine is crafted with this reverence of place—but our goal is to never stop exploring new regions and new wines.

The 2022 growing season in Oregon was a roller-coaster of various weather events and patterns that ultimately resulted in a stunning vintage for these wines. A cold, wet and late winter was punctuated with a frost event in April that was potentially harvest devastating. The cool spring persisted until late June at which point hot temperatures and an excellent fruit set lifted the collective industry's hopes. A miraculously warm, dry and long summer led into fall, allowing long ripening times with low alcohols and crisp acidity. A perfect recipe for our Christopher Michael Pinot Gris.
