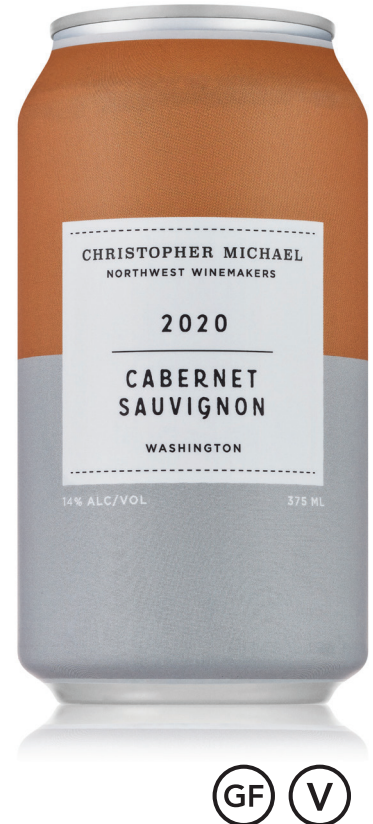

What makes the Pacific Northwest so unique? The fact that dense forests, winding waterways, and snow-packed peaks are all in our backyard? Or is it that no matter how far you go and how many sights you see, there's always more to explore? Each wine is crafted with this reverence of place—but our goal is to never stop exploring new regions and new wines.

We're creating wine for those who cherish the wonder in wandering, who understand that the best places to explore are sometimes right around the corner, and for those of us who opt for the long way home. Inspired by the Pacific Northwest, and #MadebyOregon.

The low yields, warm days, and cool nights of the 2020 vintage allowed for optimal flavor development in the fruit and complexity in the finished wines. Sourced from diverse vineyards across the state, this wine exhibits notes of berry compote, cardamom and Earl Grey tea.



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
