About Mint Cleaning:

In 2016, Monika Scott and Robyn Mair met in a parent group over discussions about their post-maternity leave plans. Neither of the women knew each other. They quickly had a plan to open a cleaning business. Ucluelet and its neighboring town of Tofino are known for hosting visitors at hotels and vacation rentals creating a high demand for good, reliable cleaners. During the COVID-19 pandemic, the creation of their own cleaning product line came to be. The business' idea to create their own non-toxic and eco-friendly products came from a place of personal health and safety. The duo used those big company chemicals when they first started but that changed when Mair, a non-smoker, had an x-ray show scarring on her lungs. Scott added that she had health symptoms that she didn't attribute to chemical products until Mair's incident. Since the creation of their first product in March 2020, the Cleaning Scrub, Mint Cleaning now has 19 products, including collaborations, ranging from laundry detergent to floor cleaner. The products are meant for all areas of a home or business, and Mint also sells refill options which is extremely important to them.
