



## Crochet Abbreviations

Some of my crochet patterns are written in UK crochet terms, but most are in both, UK and US.

However, if you need to convert any patterns please use this table to convert crochet terms from UK to US or vice versa.

| UK                    | US                   |
|-----------------------|----------------------|
| Double crochet - DC   | Single crochet -SC   |
| Half treble - HTR     | Half double - HDC    |
| Treble - TR           | Double crochet - DC  |
| Double treble - DTR   | Treble - TR          |
| Triple treble - TTR   | Double treble - DTR  |
| Miss                  | Skip                 |
| Tension               | Gauge                |
| Yarn round hook - yrh | Yarn over hook - yoh |

The full list below is written using UK terms so please adjust accordingly.

**()** - work instructions within parentheses in the place directed.

**[]** - work instructions within brackets as many times as directed

**\*** - repeat instructions following the single asterisk as directed

**\*\*** - repeat instructions between asterisks as directed

**Across** – to end of row

**Alt** – alternate

**Approx** – approximately

**Bdc** – beaded double crochet

**Beg** – beginning

**Bet** – between

**BI** – insert hook under back loop

**Bo** – bobble

**BP** – back post

**BPdc** – back post double crochet

**BPtr** – back post treble crochet

**Brdc** – back raised double crochet

**Btr** – beaded treble  
**Bs** – bullion stitch  
**CC** – contrast colour  
**Ch** – chain  
**Ch-sp** – chain space  
**CL** – cluster  
**Cm** – centimetres  
**Cont** – continue  
**Dc** – double crochet  
**Dc2tog** – double crochet two stitches together  
**Dec** - decrease/decreases/decreasing  
**Dtr** – double treble  
**Exdc** – extended double crochet  
**FL** – front loop  
**Foll** - follow/follows/following  
**FP** – front post  
**FPdc** - front post double crochet  
**FPtr** – front post treble  
**Frdc** – front raised double crochet  
**Htr** – half treble  
**Inc** - increase/increases/increasing  
**Lp(s)** – loop(s)  
**MC** – main colour  
**Miss** – skip next stitch, cluster or as directed  
**Mm** – millimetres  
**P or pc** – picot  
**Patt(s)** – pattern(s)  
**Pc** – popcorn  
**PM** – place marker  
**Prev** – previous  
**Quintr** – quintuple treble  
**Rem** - remain/remaining  
**Rep** – repeat  
**Rnd(s)** – round(s)  
**RS** – right side  
**Sextr** – sextuple treble  
**Sk** – skip  
**Sqdc** – sequined double crochet  
**Sqtr** – sequined treble  
**Sp** – space  
**Ss** – slip stitch  
**St(s)** – stitch(es)  
**Tch** – turning chain  
**Tog** – together  
**Tr** – treble crochet

**Ttr** – triple treble crochet

**WS** – wrong side

**Yd(s)** – yard(s)

**Yoh** – yarn over hook

**Yrd** – yarn round hook
