

SKU 40 HONDA CIVIC FN2 Fitting Instructions

Tools you will need:

- Combi Drill
- 5mm-13mm HSS Drill Bits
- 17mm and 19mm Spanner or Sockets
- Hammer
- Allen Key Set
- Centre Punch
- Stanley Knife (Optional)
- Tape Measure
- Marker Pen or Pencil

In your fitting kit you will have:

- M10 x 40 x 1.5 Washers (2)
- M10 Hex Head Bolt (2)
- M10 Rivet Nut (2)
- Rivet Tool
- 1. Remove the boot floor from the car, then remove the top covers for the shock absorbers.
- 2. Remove the shock absorber nuts, then place the upper mounting points of the K-Brace over the threads on both sides.
- 3. After, use a pen/pencil to mark the holes of the lower mounting points of the K-Brace.

- 4. Remove the K-Brace from the car.
- 5. Use a Centre Punch to pot the centres of each hole. Start by using a 5mm HSS Drill Bit and gradually work your way up to the required size, 13mm.
- 6. Install the M10 Rivets using the tool provided. Video Link:

- 7. Align the K-Brace and use the M10 x 20 Bolts provided to fix it into place.
- 8. Now the K-Brace is aligned measure and mark the areas of carpet and trim that need to be removed, then remove the K-Brace from the car.
- 9. Once the carpet has been adequately trimmed it can fit once again.
- 10. Finally, refit the K-Brace. Remember to fit the top mount covers, these may need a slight trim also.
