Introduction

The Anthologie quilt is a modern sampler quilt. Sampler quilts have many different blocks and techniques making them perfect for skill building.

A new pattern will release every other Monday for the Anthologie Quilt for free and will be posted on Bari J's blog.

You are encouraged to use any fabrics you may want to work with. This quilt will be particularly perfect for using fabric scraps. Fabric requirements will be listed each week along with the pattern for that particular week. If you prefer to purchase all fabrics, see the Supply List for total yardage and use as many different fabrics as you prefer to reach that yardage. There are several large pieces used in this guilt and those are called out on the Supply List separately as "background fabric". Backing, binding, and batting are also called out separately. Fabric calculations are based on 42" wide fabric.

When printing your PDF out be sure to print out in landscape format. There are several templates that will also be given, be sure to print those out with the 'fit to page' box of your print page unchecked.

All PDF patterns are clickable and will have links included for ease of use. A coloring page is included to help you plan.


