IP Rating Chart

IP stands for Ingress Protection and is formed with two numbers



The two numbers refer to two separate levels of protection

The first digit shows the level of protection against solid objects



No protection against contact and ingress



Protection from solid objects larger than 50mm diameter (hands/large tools)



Protection from solid objects larger than 12.5mm diameter (hands/large tools)



Protection from solid objects larger than 2.5mm diameter (small tools/wires)



Protection from solid objects larger than 1.0mm diameter (wires)



Sufficient protection against entry of dust that interferes with equipment



Complete dust protection (No ingress of dust)



The second digit shows the level of protection against water



No protection



Protection against vertically falling drops of water



Protection against vertically falling water drops when tilted at 15° angle



Protection against water spraying up to 60° on either side



Protection against water spraying at all practicable angles



Protection against low pressure water jets from all practicable angles



Protection against powerful water jets from all practicable angles or heavy seas



Protection against temporary submersion under defined conditions of pressure and time



Protection against continuous submersion in water
