

Changing the Bulb

- 1. Turn off the power.
- 2. Remove polycarbonate lantern cap by turning and unlocking.
- 3. After the bulb has cooled, turn it anti-clockwise to unscrew it from the lamp holder.
- 4. When installing the new bulb, turn it clockwise into the socket until it stops. Do not overtighten.
- 5. Refit lantern cap and turn to lock into place.


Installation Instructions

- 1. Fit the bolts to the triangular mounting bracket.
- 2. Run power cables through the centre of the bracket allowing a length of 2.2M to stick out of the ground.
- 3. Fix the triangular mounting bracket into the ground with cement.
- 4. Ensure you have allowed 2.2M cable.
- 5. Lock the base of the pole into the mounting bracket with provided bolts.



Installation Instructions

- 6. Fit the three parts of the pole lantern together by turning to lock into place.
- 7. Run the power cable through the pole and connect the pole to the base by turning to lock.
- 8. Slide out the connector block. Connect the mains supply to the terminal block, using the following instructions for the wiring:
 - Connect the Live wire to the corresponding terminal on the terminal block marked L.
 - Connect the Neutral wire to the corresponding terminal on the terminal block marked N.
- 9. Fit the three lantern arms running the cables through the pole juction.
- 10. Plug the three lantern arm wires into provided plugs on connector block and slide connector block back into place.
- 11. Fit the pole top cap ensuring a tight seal is made.
- 12. Slide the glasses into each of the lantern heads.
- 13. Fit the lantern heads by turning to lock into place.
- 14. Fit the E27 bulbs by turning gently until it stops. Do not over tighten.
- 15. Fit the top finials to the lantern caps turning to ensure a tight seal is made.
- 16. Fit the top caps to the three lantern heads turning to lock.
- 17. Turn on light.
