CROCHET TERMS

sl st: Slip Stitch

ch: Chain

hdc: Half Double Crochet

sc: Single Crochet
dec: Decrease Stitch
(): Indicates the total
number of stitches at the
end of each round.

Beanie



Rnd 1: 6 sc inside magic ring, sl st in first sc (6)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in same sl st, 2 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 3: 1 sc in each st around (12)

Rnd 4: *1 sc in next st, 2 sc in next

st*, repeat * to * around (18)

Rnd 5: 1 sc in each st around (18)

Rnd 6: *1 sc in next two st, 2 sc in next st*, repeat *to* around (24)

Rnd 7: 1 sc in each st around (24)

Rnd 8: *1 sc in next three st, 2 sc in

next st*, repeat *to* around (30)

Rnd 9: 1 sc in each st around (30)

Rnd 10: *1 sc in next four st, 2 sc in

next st*, repeat *to* around (36)

Rnd 11: 1 sc in each st around (36)

Rnd 12: *1 sc in next five st, 2 sc in

next st*, repeat *to* around (42)

Rnd 13- 25: 1 sc in each st around (42). Fasten off, using darning needle to weave in ends

Pom-Poms



Step 1

Please refer to instructions included with the Pom-Pom Maker to construct two pom-poms leaving at least 8 inches of yarn (this piece was used to tie yarn thread together to make pom-pom)

Step 2

Take yarn used to tie pom-pom and thread with Darning Needle. Sew ends of pom pom in to the crocheted beanie and knot. Repeat with second pom-pom
