Stash Baskets







Materials:

- 1 spool of T-Shirt yarn in three different colors (Color A, B, C)
- Jumbo Amour Crochet Hook
 P/Q-15mm (Art. No 1059/PQ)
 *6.5"x8" basket
- Darning Needle
- Scissors

Abbreviations:

- ch: chain
- sc: single crochet
- sl st: slip stitch
- rnd: round
- st(s): stitch(es)
- bpsc: back post single crochet

Pattern:

- **1st rnd:** ch 5 then sl st in first ch
- **2nd rnd:** 8 sc into center (8sts), join with sl st into first sc
- 3rd rnd: ch 1, then 2 sc in each st around (16 st), join with sl st into first sc
- 4th rnd: ch 1, * sc 1, then 2 sc in next st* Repeat around (24 sts), join with sl st into first sc
- **5th rnd:** ch 1, * sc 2, then 2 sc in next st* Repeat around (32 sts), join with sl st into first sc
- **6th rnd:** ch 1, bpsc into every st around (32 sts), join with sl st (forms basket base)
- 7-14th rnd: ch 1, *sc 1 into every st all the way around* (32 sts). Join with a sl st. Repeat for 7 more rounds
- **15th rnd:** join Color B, ch 1, sc 32 in each st all the way around. Join with sl st into first sc
- **16-17th rnd:** join Color A again, ch 1, sc 32, join with sl st into first sc. Repeat for another round.
- 18th rnd: join Color C, ch 1, sc 32, join with sl st into first sc
- 19th rnd: ch 1, *sc 12, ch 8 (skipping for chains of the 18th rnd)* Repeat from * one more time, join with sl st
- **20th rnd:** ch 1, *sl st 12, 8 sc into handle space* Repeat from * one more time, join with sl st
- Using a darning needle, weave in ends

Materials:

- 2 spools of T-Shirt yarn in two different colors
- Jumbo Amour Crochet Hook P/Q-15mm (Art. No 1059/PQ) *For a larger basket
- bosker porkerns Jumbo Amour Crochet Hook 12mm (Art. No 1058) *For a smaller, tighter basket (about 14"x10")

Pattern:

Using the Magic Circle method begin with main body color (Make a slip knot and hold it open to form a circular ring. Pull the yarn up into the ring and ch 1. Then work 5 sc in the ring around the ring and tail yarn. Tighten the circle by pulling on the tail. SI st into the first stitch to join the round.)

- **1st rnd:** 5 sc in magic circle* and join with sl st into first sc
- **2nd rnd:** ch 1, then 2 sc in each st around (10 sts), join with sl st into first sc
- **3rd rnd:** ch 1, then 2 sc in each st around (20 st), join with sl st into first sc
- 4th rnd: ch 1, * sc 1, then 2 sc in next st* Repeat around (30 sts), join with sl st into first sc
- **5th rnd:** ch 1, sc 30, join with sl st into first sc
- 6th rnd: ch 1, *sc 5, then 2 sc in next st* Repeat around (35 sts), join with sl st into first sc
- 7th rnd: ch 1, *sc 1, then 2 sc in next stitch* Repeat around, sc 1 in last stitch (52 sts), join with sl st into first sc
- 8th rnd: ch 1, sc 52 in the back loop of each st (rather than

through both loops). This creates the bottom of the basket. Join with sl st into first sc

- **9-16th rnd:** ch 1, sc 52, join with sl st into first sc.
- **17-18th rnd:** using contrasting color, join and ch 1, sc 52, join with sl st into first sc. At this point you may complete the basket in the second color or just make a contrasting stripe with rnds 17 & 18 and go back to the main color
- **19th rnd:** ch 1, sc 9, ch 8, skip 8 sts, sc 18, sc 18, ch 8, skip 8 sts, sc 9 (52 sts), join with sl st into first sc
- **20th rnd:** ch 1, sc 9, sc 10 in the ch 8 space, sc 18, sc 10 in ch 8 space, sc 9 (56 sts) join with sl st into first sc
- **21st rnd:** ch 1, sc 56, sl st to 1st sc of round to join and fasten off and weave in ends
- Turn work inside out the side you have been working on is the outside of the basket
