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
Lets craft with our Applique Mat

Jar of Flowers

Materials:

- Clover Applique Mat (Art. no. 4095)
- Clover Wonder Fuse (Art. no. 4090 or 4091)
- Clover Point 2 Point Turner (Art. No. 7803)
- Clover Wonder Clips (Art. No. 3155)
- 9" square of Green Fabric For stems and leaves
- 1" x 5" strip of Orange Fabric for center of flowers
- 4" square of 5 different fabrics for floweres
- 12" x 14" piece of fabric for the lace

- 12-1/2" x 17-1/2" Fabric for the center
- 12-1/2" x 17-1/2" Fabric for the back

Instructions:



1. Make sure your images are mirror imaged (Reversed). Trace your Applique designs onto the paper side of the Wonder Fuse, following the manufacturer's instructions.

Cut out applique design, leaving approximitely 1/4 to 1/2 inch around the design. Place the applique design to the wrong side of chosen fabric. Then press.



Cut out applique on the traced line. Remove paper backing.

For the Lace:

Fold the 12" x 14" fabric in half (6" x 14"). Open the fabric up. Cut a piece of Wonder Fuse 6" x 14" and fuse to the wrong side of the fabric. This will fuse the wrong sides together of the $6" \times 14"$.


Fold the 12" x 14" fabric in half (6" x 14"). Open the fabric up. Cut a piece of Wonder Fuse 6" x 14" and fuse to the wrong side of the fabric. This will fuse the wrong sides together of the 6" x 14".

Next, cut a 2-1/2 Strip of Wonder Fuse and fuse it across the TOP of the right side of the fabric.

Now cut out the Paper Template for the lace. Pin the paper template to the fabric and cut out the fabric.

Now you are ready to start fusing onto the Clover Applique Mat.

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2. Place the Applique Mat over your pattern. You will start by Layering the pattern pieces from the back piece upward. Leaves, stems, flowers, flower centers, scalloped fabric, ribbion, and vase.



Place the leaves in place, cover with Teflon sheet then fuse in place. Place the stems in place, cover with Teflon sheet then fuse in place. Continue this method till project is completed.



3. When the flower vase project is cooled, carefully peel the project from the applique mat. Now place the project on your center fabric and press.



4. You can now finish the edges with a satin stitch, zig zag, applique stitch or a straight Stitch.

5. Putting your project together. Lay the design fabric right side up. Fold the scalloped fabric up.

Next, lay the batting on the top of the design fabric.

Next, lay the backing right side down on top of the batting.

Clip the layers together using Clover Wonder Clips.

- 6. Mark 1" from both sides on the bottom, leaving this as your opening for tuning. Using a 1/4' seam, stitch around the project. Then, clip your corners.
- 7. Turn your project right side out. Using the Point 2 Point Turner, Push the corner points out. Then, Pull down the scalloped fabric.
- 8. Using a 1/4" stitch, stitch the bottom opening up.





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
