When Jesus was asked, "Of all the commandments, which is the most important?", he replied with the above statement. To form these principles, we used this scripture passage along with the statements that make mainly Ministries unique.

To be in this together, we welcome everyone. *Love your neighbour as yourself*. We encourage all those involved in mainly Ministries to remain focused and committed to this commandment. Together, we create joy-filled opportunities for Jesus to be revealed

To create joy-filled opportunities, we need to create a space where people can fill with joy.

- There is biblical mandate laid out in Romans 13 to comply with government regulations and directives, where they don't breach biblical imperatives for the church and followers of Jesus. Compliance, even though at times inconvenient, enables safety and protocols to protect both partner churches, partner organisations, and attending families.
- We acknowledge and care about the vulnerability of pregnant women, young children, grandparents, and older aged volunteers.
- To do this together, mainly Ministries will do everything we can to contribute to partner churches/organisations and participating families for Jesus to be revealed through all we do.
- Knowing there are differing opinions in this journey, as an organisation, we will support every partner and family in any way we can, holding in tension Government regulations and directives. As an organisation, we are following Government regulations.
