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Cut a 5 " piece of braided 18 g tinned copper wire. Solder the wire to the solder line that is connecting the art and float glass.

Another view of the back side of the frame. Be careful that the clips and braided wire for hanging are not interferring with the ability for the photo to sit flush.

I used an $20 g$ tinned copper wire to make four clips, one on each edge to hold the photo in place. Once you have made your clips, solder them into the solder line surrounding the float glass.
