We are proud to offer two primary cassock ranges which can be ordered through our website: the Essential Cassock and Custom Cassocks. Our Essential Cassocks are fully standardised: each is single-breasted, made in a lightweight pure wool, and include brush braid, fabric-covered buttons, and cuffs. They cannot be altered or customised.


Alternatively, our Custom Cassocks are available in a wide range of sizes - both single and double-breasted - with various customisable features such as fabrics, additional piping, and a choice of buttons.


Custom Cassock sizes

Our Essential & Custom Cassocks are cut to your specific chest size and back length. All other measurements are standard, in proportion to the chest and back. Please use these guides to determine which size you require.

Please check that these sizes are suitable for you; for example if you have a larger stomach you may need to choose a bigger chest size to accommodate it. The sleeve length is determined by the back length. If your arm is shorter than the standard sleeve measurement it is possible for us to alter this in house at additional cost (Custom Cassocks only).

## How to Measure



We only take two measurements for our cassocks: a **chest size** and a **back length**. Collar, waist, across back, and shoulder are determined by your chest size. Sleeve length is determined by your back length.

How to measure: Please ask someone to help you take your measurements.

**A. Chest:** Place the tape under the arms and around the fullest part of the chest, allow room for two fingers underneath.

**B. Waist:** Measure around the natural waistline, breathe out naturally and take your measurement.

**C. Collar:** The collar size on the cassock is determined by the collar size you would usually wear.

**D. Shoulder:** Place the tape at the base of your collar and measure across to the end of your shoulder.

**E. Across Back:** Place the tape horizontally across the shoulder blades, measuring underarm to underarm.

**F. Back Length:** Ensure you are wearing the shoes you would usually wear with a cassock. Place the tape at the nape of your neck and extend down to where you would like the hem of the cassock to sit.

**G. Sleeve:** Measure from the end of the shoulder, along the length of your arm to the point just past the wrist-bone.
