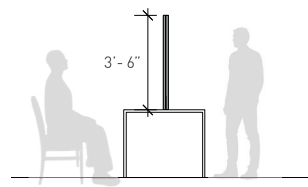
300 Frame

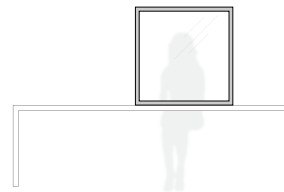
PERIMETER FRAME



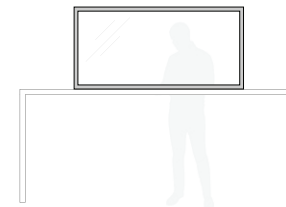

SIDE FRAME



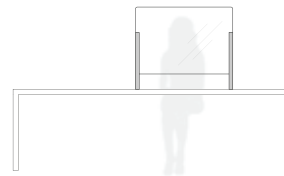

Ideal for scenarios where you must communicate across a barrier

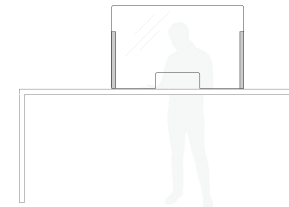

Great as a screen/guard at computer workstations

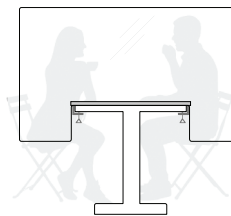

First you'll need to consider how it will be used - to separate two seated people? A seated and a standing person? People walking past one another?

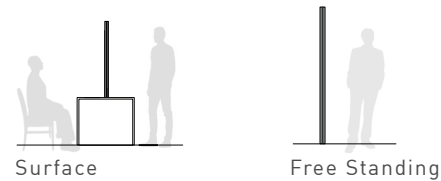

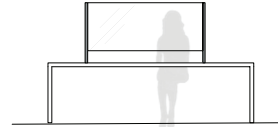

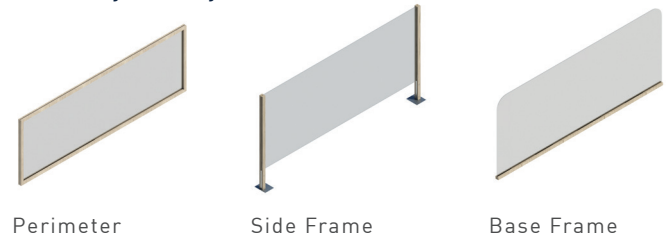
