



HOT WAX INSTRUCTIONS

Brow Preparation

Cleanse the brow area with an oil-free foaming cleanser. Rinse with a damp cotton pad. Ensure brows are dry and free of oils and sebum.

Brush the brows upwards and map as needed.

Hot Wax Preparation

Brow Code Hot Wax is best used at 70° Celsius/158° Fahrenheit. Heat the wax until it is completely melted with a honey-like consistency. If you find the wax too stringy, this means the wax is not warm enough.

Check the temperature of the wax before use with a patch test on the inside of the wrist.

Hot Wax Application

Apply the wax with a spatula at a 90-degree angle to the skin, following the direction of hair growth. Create a thick edge at the end of the strip of wax to assist with the removal process. Move the spatula back and forth to tie off any stringy wax.

Hot Wax Removal

Allow the wax to cool before removal. Lift the edge of the wax strip slightly, while holding the skin taut, pull the wax off in the opposite direction of hair growth.

Brush the brows into place.
