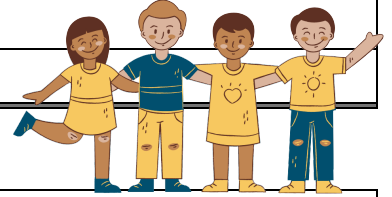

3. Classes are normally without parental attendance.
4. Children must be washroom independent, as no assistance will be provided.
5. Children are not permitted to leave the premises for any reason unless accompanied by the authorized parent/guardian or permitted by a written letter of consent by the parent/guardian named on this form. It is understood that JB Arts will have no responsibility towards that student.
6. JB Arts maintains a zero tolerance for theft.
7. Electronic devices are allowed during working time or break time but not during teaching time. Electronic devices can be taken away, with just cause and returned at the end of the session.
8. Children may be removed from the program at the discretion of the instructor, with no refund.
