Beauty – NOT the Beast

Every sound must be the most beautiful and meaningful it can be Let's Start at the Very Beginning, a Very Good Place to Start...

Posture

Upright, no touching allowed Bring the instrument to you

Breathing

Deeply with focus, through the mouth More air = better sound

Embouchure

Corners firm, center relaxed Reed instruments need to use as much reed as possible

First Sounds

Open throat, teeth and ears! Listen/emulate/experiment

Use exemplary teaching materials

Good demonstration models
Excellent recordings
The best audio and video representations
Sometimes even advanced students can use a reminder of the fundamentals!
Encourage Private Lessons

Choose Repertoire Wisely

Find pieces that encourage beautiful sounds

Use Warm-Up Time for Reinforcement

Review good habits
Insist on the best tone every time
Ask students to comment on the sound and offer suggestions for improvement
Find students who can demonstrate to model great tone
