- 5. How would you tackle prejudice and stereotyping in your lesson? (Avoiding stereotypes in examples and resources)
- 6. Use resources with multicultural themes and actively promote multiculturalism in lessons.
- 7. Explore different musical styles and music by musicians from different backgrounds and traditions
- 8. Use music to explore aspects of personal identity, social problems and issues
- 9. Learn about the history of genres (such as reggae, blues and calypso).
