The first recipient for the month of March is the **World Wildlife Organisation** charity who protect the world's most endangered species. Here is a bit of info on the charity, and what they do.

"We work to conserve the world's most important natural places and significantly change global forces to protect the future of nature. Our experts are active at every level—from field work to government—conserving the largest tropical rain forests, the most remote areas of our planet, and the world's most endangered species."

And this month, in the month of March, we have decided to adopt a beautiful Tiger!



There could be as few as 3,200 tigers in the wild, most in isolated pockets spread across increasingly fragmented forests, stretching from India to southeastern China and from the Russian Far East to Sumatra, Indonesia. Largest of all cats, the tiger is one of the most threatened species on Earth. Tigers prefer to eat hoofed animals, but will also prey on fish, birds and even other predators like leopards and bears. These beautiful cats are threatened by growing human populations, loss of habitat, illegal hunting (of both tigers and their prey species) and expanded trade in tiger parts used as traditional medicines.

With 100% of the donations going directly to the welfare of the Tigers, we felt that it was a great charity in need of our help! And thanks to you all, we have been able to adopt a Tiger in need for 1 year providing him/her with care, welfare, food, veterinary costs and a rehabilitation programme run by dedicated vets and keepers.
