



1.4 Intended use

The portable gaming desk case is intended for indoor use only.

The portable gaming desk case is intended for seated use only.

Use the portable gaming desk case only as described in this user manual.

The product is intended for personal and residential use only and NOT for business environments.

The portable gaming desk is intended for users over the age of 13 years. Adult supervision required for users under the age of 18.

Only use certified and market approved computer components with the product.

Only use form factor components described in this manual.

Install computer components only to the designated locations described in this manual.

Make sure the components you install are compatible with one another.

1.5 Non-conventional use

Only use this product in the ways and for the purposes specified in this manual.

Obey all safety information.

Only install and use the product as described in this user manual.

It is strictly forbidden to use the portable gaming desk in any other way or for any other purpose than those described in this user manual.

Do not disassemble any parts of the product that is not specifically described as a removable.

1.6 Ambient condition for use

Only use the portable gaming desk in the following conditions:

The product should only be used in environments with ambient temperatures between 10°C - 30°C. Avoid dust, humidity, and temperature extremes. Do not place the product in any area where it may become wet.

1.7 Warranty information

Limited warranty and limitations of liability. This product is guaranteed for sixty (60) months from the date of delivery to end-user, against defects in materials and/or workmanship. Within this limited warranty period, the product will either be repaired or replaced at Unevn's discretion. The warranty does not cover: Products which have been used for rental purposes, misused, handled carelessly or applied in such a way that is not in accordance with its stated intended use; products damaged from an Act of Nature including, but not limited to, lightning, fire, flood and earthquake and/or products whose serial number and/or the warranty sticker have been tampered with or removed.



2. Safety

2.1 Signal words and symbols

2.2 Main risks related to the installation, use, maintenance, and disassembly of the product

M DANGER

Risk of electrocution.

Make sure that the main power cord is disconnected before performing any installation, maintenance, or disassembly.

Before using the product, ensure all the cables are correctly connected and the power cables are not damaged. If you detect any damage, stop using the product and contact UNEVN or your dealer immediately.



To avoid short circuits, keep paper clips, screws, staples or other metallic objects away from the computer case, connectors, slots, sockets or circuitry.

Do not place anything else than specifically described in this user manual inside the computer case.

Before touching anything within the computer case or connecting or removing any cables from computer components, ensure that the power cables are unplugged.

If the power supply is broken, do not try to fix it yourself.

Contact a qualified service technician, UNEVN or your retailer.

Use only certified and market approved components with the desk case.

Fire hazard. Risk of severe burns.



Faulty electrical components can cause fires.

Keep the product clear of flammable materials.

Make sure that an appropriate and operational fire extinguisher or other fire suppression means are readily available at the site of use.

If smoke detected or smell of melting or burning material, stop using the product immediately and unplug the main power cord if possible.

Hot surface hazard.



Risk of burns from hot surfaces.

In prolonged use the temperature of the glass may rise to 50°C.

Do not touch the glass during use.

After the product has been turned off, make sure that the glass has cooled down before storing.



Squeezing hazard. Risk of injury to hands.

Do not put your hands or fingers between the desk and the while closing the lid.

Use caution when using and preparing the monitor stand.

Maximum weight hazard



Do not sit, stand, or place heavy objects on the desk. Risk of desk cracking.

Do not use monitors of over 5kg on the monitor stand.

Place the product on a stable surface.

Make sure the desk is stable and in horizontal position by adjusting the leveling feet.

Ergonomic hazard. Risk of injury.



The product is heavy. Do not attempt to lift the product alone if you do not feel comfortable doing so. Always use caution and have two (2) people if needed.

Always proceed with caution while moving the product to avoid damage to the product, people or other property.





Save the package for transportation!








5.4.5 Use of functions - Lid locks (self locking locks)

Use lid locks only for static storaging. DO NOT RELY ON THEM FOR TRANSPORTATION! Locks might open when moving the product. Use the package to securely transport the product.

NOTE: If the lid is not opening, sqeeze the front together to unlock the gravitation lock.
