Own single vineyard

A selection of the best grapes available from our 9hectare (22 acres) single vineyard called Canajas, located at 465 m altitude and planted in 1950. Its soil is mainly iron-clay with a stony topsoil, which favours optimal ripening. After veraison, cropthinning is carried out to limit production up to 1 kg vine, selecting bunches with small, concentrated berries.

Grape variety

86% Tempranillo, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 4% Graciano.

Alcohol content

14,5% abv.

Manual harvest

Graciano was harvested on September 28 cabernet sauvignon on September 29 and tempranillo on September 30.

Winemaking

Once received at the winery, grapes are first de-stemmed and carefully selected. Then, each grape variety ferments separately for around 10 days in 13,900 - litre Allier French oak vats at controlled temperature. During this period, regular pumping over and delestage are carried out to ensure a perfect extraction of polyphenolic compounds.

Ageing process

20 months in Allier French oak barrels and 6 months in concrete vats before bottling.
