Introduction
Cut apart the tray.

1 Dumpling mold
2 Naruto/egg mold




Cut the dumpling mold roundly with the line.


1 Make dumplings!




1 Break a candy. Put some candy aside for naruto and egg according to the pastry bag's guide.




2 Divide the remaining candy in half, and expand them to the pastry bag's guide.



3 Place the expanded candies on the dumpling mold, press them to make recesses.



4 Put the filling mix. Fold the mold and press sides together. Be careful not to spill powder from the mold.



5 Remove from the mold and done! Make two pieces of dumpling.

Done. Chew it. Juicy!

2 Make ramen!



1 Pour water up to the line on the side of the tray ♪. Put the "soup mix" and mix it well.



2 Pour water up to the line on the side of the tray ☆. Put the "noodle mix" and mix it well.



3 Make a small hole at the corner of the pastry bag with the pick from the inside to the outside.



4 Fold back the top of the pastry bag. Put the "noodle mix" and twist the top of the bag.



5 Squeeze the "noodle mix" around in the "soup." Ramen is made!

3 Make naruto and egg!



1 Press the remaining candy in the mold and make naruto and egg.



2 Put the "noodle mix" a little over the egg.
