

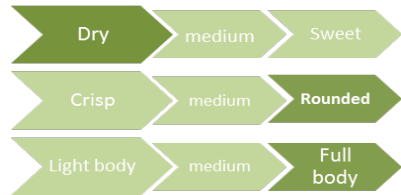
Beauvignac Chardonnay

Rich, round and warm, this buttery oaky Chardonnay is cut with fresh citrus, baked apple and spiked with cloves, with superb length.

Food match: Delicious with rich fish and chicken dishes, such as scallops, creamy monkfish or cod.
