- Producer: Château Haut-Bardin, owned by the Dumas family for six generations, is located in the commune of Saint-Martial, 50 kilometres south-east of the city of Bordeaux. The estate is 120ha.
- Varieties: Merlot (70%) and Cabernet sauvignon (30%). These vines average 25 years of age.
- Vinification is classic in style, carried out in stainless steel so that the fruit shows quite clearly.
