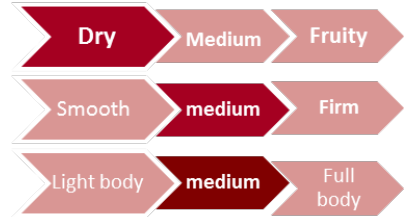


Ch. Haut Brignot Haut-Médoc 2015

Deep purple. Lovely classic Bordeaux, with savoury notes of autumnal forest floor, tobacco leaf, blackberry, woodsmoke. Medium-bodied, and pleasantly firm, but yielding.



Food match: Perfect with red meats, particularly beef.

What's special about this wine?

- This wine represents exceptional value for money. It is also from the 2015 vintage, a superb vintage in Bordeaux.
- 2015: Gold medal Gilbert & Gaillard.
- Silver, Bordeaux Concours 2018

Like to know more?

- Origin: Haut-Médoc is a 60km stretch along Bordeaux's left Bank. The area is prized for premium quality wines, capable of lengthy ageing.
- Varietals: 50% Merlot (giving softness, and red fruit) ,50% Cabernet Sauvignon (adds tannin and black fruit).

This wine is matured in a mixture of oak, to give just the right amount of oaky notes.
