- Origin: Listrac-Médoc sits just north of Médoc, before the Haut-Médoc region in Bordeaux's Left Bank. The estate sits on a gravel ridge above clay soil.
- Producer: this property is owned by Bruno Borie, who also manages the renowned Ch. Ducru Beaucaillou.
- Varietals: 50% Merlot (giving softness, and red fruit) ,40%
 Cabernet Sauvignon (adds tannin and black fruit), 10% Petit
 Verdot (savoury, tobacco and spice). Named after the windmill which milled grain for the town of Listrac en Medoc.
