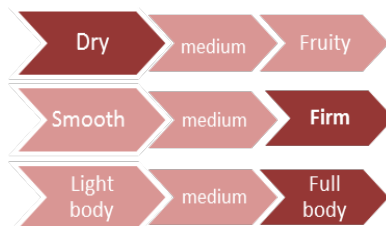
Lussac St. Émilion
