

Château La Raze Beauvallet, Haut Médoc, Cru Bourgeois

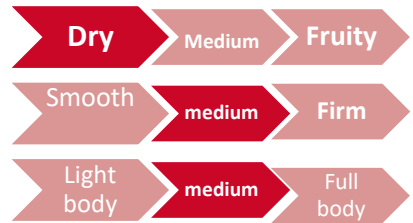

- The 90ha property is situated in the centre of the village of Civrac en-Médoc near Lesparre. The château is a beautiful C19th building. In the grounds there is a large, very old underground chamber which is said to have been used for pagan rites before the construction of the nearby Romanesque church
- 55% Cabernet Sauvignon, ± 45% Merlot
