

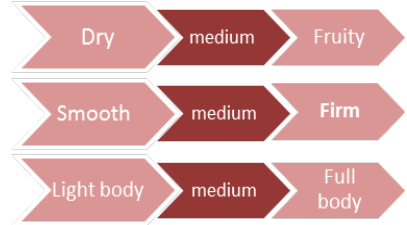
# Château du Donjon Grand Tradition Minervois

Wonderful layers of flavours: lead pencil, wood, blackcurrant, blueberry, vanilla and a lovely long spicy finish. Medium tannins and body.

**Food match:** Roast lamb, lamb cutlets, especially with mint sauce.

- Origin: Minervois in the Languedoc
- Varieties: 60% Grenache, 30% Syrah, 10% Carignan
- Property: The winery is named after the 15th century castle, which is on the property. 'Donjon' is a keep. Jean Panis is the winemaker. Their family has been making wine here for generations, and specialises in Minervois AC.
