

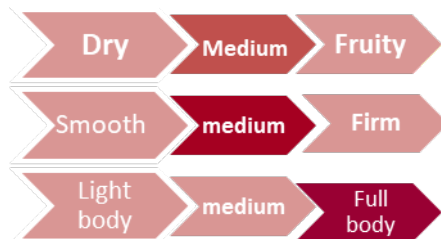
Crôzes-Hermitages, *Ranvier Dauvergne*

Rich & satisfying. Wonderful perfume of violets and savoury leather. This Syrah (Shiraz) is full-bodied, with plenty of ripe dark fruit, spice, liquorice, white pepper. Very satisfying.

- Crôzes-Hermitages is one of 17 'Crus' of the Rhône valley. It is situated in the Northern Rhône. It is said to have 'seductive robustness.' It drinks well in youth, becoming savoury with age. It's a large appellation. This wine comes from the southern part, which is covered in round pebbles, giving fruit rather than tannin.
